Forced state employees to make a 3% contribution to FRS and supported Republican efforts to gut the system.

Was CEO of Columbia/HCA during the time the company committed Medicare fraud that resulted in \$1.7 billion in fines. As Gov., he failed to implement Medicaid expansion to help a million people in the health coverage gap.

Instituted a voter purge that targeted minority voters and made it harder for convicted felons to regain their voting rights.

Charlie Crist



Came out strongly in support of leaving the successful public employee pension system alone, not targeting state workers.

As Gov. advocated a low-cost insurance plan for uncovered Floridians. Has said he would fight to expand Medicaid by accepting billions in federal aid to Florida taxpayers that Scott and House Republicans have refused to take.

Extended voting hours in 2008 when long lines threatened to disenfranchise thousands. Signed legislation for the restoration of voting rights for nonviolent offenders.
